#### **CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FROM ORGANISED EMPLOYER AND ORGANISED EMPLOYEE ORGANISATIONS TO SERVE ON TETA GOVERNING STRUCTURES FOR THE PERIOD APRIL 2010 TO MARCH 2012**

Interested organised employer and organised employee organisations within the transport sector are invited to submit an application for their organisation and nomination of the names of individuals, member and alternate, to serve on the respective Chamber Management Committees (MANCOMS) of the Transport Education Training Authority (TETA). The Board will then be constituted from the eight chamber office bearers and representatives from TETA strategic partners.

The scope of coverage of the SETA is the transport sector as determined and defined in terms of Section 9(2) of the Skills Development Act 1998 (amended 2008) and by Notice No. 316 published in the Government Gazette.

#### **TETA scope encompasses the following chambers:**

- Aerospace
- Forwarding and clearing
- Freight handling
- Maritime
- Rail
- Road freight
- Road passenger
- Taxi.

#### **Criteria for organised employee and organised employer organisations to serve on Mancom structures and Board:**

- Must be organised employee or organised employer organisations (including small businesses), active in the transport sector and within the sub-sectors listed above. Evidence of representation may be called for where this is questioned.
- Professional bodies, national government departments and bargaining councils active in the transport sector may also apply for seats on the Mancom structures but serve as ex-officio members.

#### **The following criteria will apply for the nominees of the constituency bodies who must:**

- Have an excellent understanding of SETA functions, the transport sector, skills development and related legislation (PFMA, SDLA, SAQA, Treasury Regulations, LRA, BCEA, EE, BBBEE, etc.) as well as Codes of Good Practice
- Be mandated by their respective organisations to act, make decisions and vote on behalf of the organisations and sub-sectors they represent to the benefit of the transport sector
- Have an excellent understanding of business practices, business risks, corporate governance, finance and audit, skills development, quality assurance and human resources practices related to public entities
- Have appropriate experience and skills to ensure an appropriate duty of skill and care in exercising their fiduciary duties as per the requirements of the PFMA, Companies Act and King Report on Corporate Governance
- Represent TETA's interests and contribute towards the strategic objectives of the organisation and the transport sector
- Be prepared to serve on the TETA Board and other governance structures if nominated and attend meeting on a regular basis
- Declare any outside interests, third party-related transactions/any conflicting interest.

Organisations must submit such applications and nominations on their respective organisations letterhead, providing relevant contact details.
