This communication serves to advise regarding the 2012 Mandatory Grant submission criteria and online system.

It is to be read in conjunction with the TETA MG Advertisement.

We apologize for delay regarding communication of criteria and system updates:

- TETA did not finalize criteria until the close of the 11/12 financial year to allow for any draft regulations, if signed before financial year end to be incorporated into criteria.
- The system enhancements (to improve on last year system) and updates (to draft funding regulations) were then set to specification and developed (April).
- TETA is currently piloting the SDF interface to ensure there are no system issues when the system is launched (April and May).

It is expected that the system will open for submissions by 11 May 2012.

Week 07 – 11 May is for final piloting and uploading of supporting documentation onto the system.
