Invitation to nominate individuals for the prestigious International Leadership Development Programme (ILDP)

The ILDP is an initiative of the Transport Education & Training Authority (TETA) aimed at accelerating the development of future leaders in the Transport Sector.

An invitation for applications and nominations for the ILDP programme is hereby extended to TETA constituencies and stakeholders in the following sub-sectors:

- Taxi
- Aerospace
- Road Passenger

The ILDP is an accelerated, high intensity training programme targeted at prospective managers drawn from the Historically Disadvantaged Groups, as articulated in the BBBEE Act, Section 9(4) and the TETA Strategic Plan Document 2012/13-2015/1.

The programme will accommodate 30 participants. The programme comprises local and international training destinations, with the international leg scheduled in March 2015.
