

EXTENSION OF DEADLINE FOR CALL FOR TRANSPORT SECTOR ACCOUNTING AUTHORITY MEMBERS NOMINATIONS FOR THE TRANSPORT EDUCATION AND TRAINING AUTHORITY (01 APRIL 2025 – 31 MARCH 2030)

TETA hereby notifies the Transport sector constituencies that the deadline for submission of nominations has been extended to 15 December 2024. Employer organisations, organised labour, government departments, regulatory, any interested professional bodies, bargaining councils in the transport sector and community organisations interested in skills development, are hereby encouraged to nominate prospective members of the TETA Board as contemplated in section 11 of the Skills Development Act 97 of 1998.

The selection of TETA Board members to be appointed by the Minister of Higher Education and Training will be based on the following characteristics:

- Must be drawn from the rank of the senior officials in the relevant organisations
- Requisite knowledge, skills and experience to serve on the SETA Board
- Representativity of designated groups such as women and persons with disability
- Full grasp of the functioning of SETAs and appropriate competencies including corporate governance and ethics
- Knowledge and understanding of the skills development legislation and the National Skills Development Plan and their implications for SETA performance
- Additionally, the nominees must have personal traits of objectivity, integrity and commitment.

Constituencies should use the following criteria as guidelines when selecting their nominees: The nominee must preferably have intensive sectoral knowledge, technical skills and expertise in the following areas:

- The powers, duties and functions of the Accounting Authority, corporate governance and ethics
- Skills development regulatory and legislative framework
- SETA's responsibility in respect of service delivery
- Financial management
- The Sector and/or the Constituency represented by the Member
- The strategic leadership capabilities
- Skills development and training
- Quality assurance of learning provision
- General management and business skills
- The communication and stakeholder management capabilities and preferably persons in possession of NQF level 7 or above.
