Delegates are required to apply their learnings to identified sectoral challenges in support of TETA's goal to foster economic and leadership development. The programme, which is the SETA's contribution to transforming the sector, aims to build a network of empowered leaders that can leverage each other's experiences to improve their own companies' strategic sustainability while responding to urgent economic and social challenges.

ENTRANCE CRITERIA

Due to the intensity of this programme, applicants will be required to:

- demonstrate a high level of personal motivation, stamina and initiative and show a willingness to work in a group, as well as an ability to tolerate and manage pressure and conflict
- be 25 years or older
- have a minimum of 3 years' relevant work experience
- be in possession of an NQF level 7 qualification
- be fluent in spoken and written English.

RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING

If the nominee does not have the required formal educational qualifications specified by this degree, but their age, work and life experiences have provided them with equivalent levels of learning, they are encouraged to proceed with their application by following the steps below.

The Admissions Board will review their application, and they will be supplied with further instructions should the Admissions Board recommend that they apply via the RPL process.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Please follow the steps outlined below to ensure that you comply with the TETA SETA and UCT GSB application requirements. Applications which do not comply with the below will not be considered.

 - Please note: this form must be completed and signed by the authorised company representative to nominate beneficiaries for application.
 - Each nominee must also sign the form in the space provided.
2. Obtain from your Recommending Manager or Authorised Company Representative a **Letter of Recommendation / Motivation**.
 - This letter should be provided on a Company Letterhead clearly indicating the Nominee's name, position, and dates of employment.
3. **Certify a copy of your Identity Document.**
 - Please note that the certification should not be older than 3 months
4. **Update your CV**
5. **Certify copies of your degree or diploma** (obtained from a Technikon or University)
 - Please note that the certification should not be older than 3 months
6. **Certify a copy of the academic record or transcript for your degree or diploma**
 - Please note that the certification should not be older than 3 months
7. If you are not in possession of a Degree or Diploma, and wish to apply via the **Recognition of Prior Learning Process**, please certify a copy of your Matric Certificate as well as certificates of any short courses you may have completed.
 - Please note that the certification should not be older than 3 months
