

EXTENDED INVITATION FOR NOMINATIONS TO SERVE ON THE EIGHT (8) TETA CHAMBERS

1 APRIL 2025 – 31 MARCH 2030

The Transport Education and Training Authority hereby invites nominations (extension invitation for nominees who did not submit previously) submissions for suitably qualified persons from organised labour, organised employers and relevant government departments, transport sector bargaining councils, community organisations with interest in the transport sector to serve as members of the Aerospace, Forward and Clearing, Freight Handling, Maritime, Rail, Road Passenger, Road freight and Taxi Chambers for a term linked to the tenure of the new TETA Board. The Chambers report to the TETA Board and are responsible for the eight transport sub-sectors.

Minimum requirements:

- The members must have relevant qualifications or experience and competencies in the sectors for which they have been nominated such as the aerospace, maritime, rail, transport, forward and clearing and freight handling, etc.

Competencies:

- Community development, skills development, economic development, project management, risk management, human resources and labour relations, entrepreneurial skills, quality assurance, information and communication technology and governance.

Constituencies:

- The nominated members must represent the following constituencies in the relevant subsector •labour organisation's, •employer organisation's, • Government departments that have an interest in the sector and may not be organised employers • Interested professional bodies • Bargaining councils in the transport sector; and • community organisations that have an identifiable interest in skills development in the sector.

The Chambers have, inter alia, the following duties:

- To oversee the functional performance of TETA sub-sectors and guarantee the implementation of the relevant chamber's business plan
- Determine the chamber's skills development priorities
- Monitor and ensure compliance with laws and regulations
- Reviewing the performance of relevant TETA sub-sector and recommend appropriate interventions to the Board
- Ensure chamber inputs to the Transport Sector Skills Plan (SSP)
- Give strategic direction and guidance to the relevant chamber
- Ensure requisite independent professional advice on the workings of the sub-sector in the quest for skills development and economic transformation
- Ensure stakeholder management and collaboration in the relevant sub-sector
- Nominees must exhibit understanding of the functioning of SETAs in terms of requirements relating to corporate governance and ethics
- Knowledge and understanding of the skills development landscape, National Skills Development Plan (NSDP) and their implications for SETA performance & PFMA and its regulatory prescripts
- Must have an appropriate blend of knowledge, skills and experience as well as personal attributes of objectivity, integrity and commitment.
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The constituencies must submit

- a cover letter clearly specifying their constituency and the chamber for which they are nominating
- an acceptance of nomination
- a Curriculum Vitae with at least two references • recently certified ID copy
- a certified proof of qualifications and experience.

In addition, stakeholders are encouraged to nominate women with relevant expertise and experience. Preference will be given to nominees whose appointments will enhance social representativity and gender equity.
