TETA is currently conducting a study that will assess the current level of readiness of the transport sector to adopt and implement green transport practices and technologies, as well as to identify the skills and knowledge gaps that need to be addressed to facilitate this transition. The study seeks to identify challenges that could hinder the transition to green economy in the transport sector as well as identify subsectors most likely to be affected by the transition to green transport. Focus will also be on training and educational programmes or initiatives available to develop skills related to green transport. The study will explore implications of the transition from the traditional modes of transport to green transport. The final report will provide recommendations on strategies to develop the necessary skills of the transport workforce for the transition to green transport.
