

REOPENING OF NOMINATIONS FOR MEMBERS OF THE ACCOUNTING AUTHORITY OF THE TRANSPORT EDUCATION AND TRAINING AUTHORITY

The Transport Education and Training Authority, following the directive of the DHET directive dated 05 August 2025, hereby invites employer organisations, organised labour, government departments, regulatory and Professional Bodies, Bargaining Councils in the transport sector, community organisations, to nominate prospective members of the TETA Board as contemplated in section 11 of the Skills Development Act 97 of 1998 and the TETA Constitution for 2025 – 2030 tenure.

The appointment of the TETA Board members by the Executive Authority of Higher Education will be based on the following attributes:

- Must be drawn from the rank of the senior officials in the above-mentioned constituencies;
- Requisite knowledge, skills and experience to serve on the SETA Board;
- Representativity of designated groups such as women, youth and persons with disability;
- Full grasp of the functioning of SETAs and appropriate competencies including corporate governance and ethics;
- Knowledge and understanding of the skills development legislation and the National Skills Development Plan and their implications for SETA performance; and
- Additionally, the nominees must have personal traits of objectivity, integrity and commitment.

Constituencies should use the following criteria as guidelines when selecting their nominees: The nominee must preferably have intensive sectoral knowledge, technical skills and expertise in the following areas:

- the powers, duties and functions of the Accounting Authority, corporate governance and ethics;
- Skills development and/or community development;
- SETA's responsibility in respect of service delivery;
- Financial management;
- Strategic leadership capabilities;
- Skills development and training;
- Quality assurance of learning provision;
- General management and business skills; and
- Communication and stakeholder management capabilities

The nominations must be accompanied by:

- A nomination and acceptance letter;
- The curriculum vitae;
- Certified copies of Identity Document and Qualifications, (preferably persons in possession of NQF level 7 or above, including SAQA qualification report where applicable);
- MIE or SAPS Clearance (where available);
- Completed declaration of interest in term of section 11C of the SDA [Click here for the Declaration form](#)
